IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE CHARLESTON TOWNSHIP CLERK'S OFFICE:

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CHARLESTON TOWNSHIP, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, STATE OF MICHIGAN WILL BE CONDUCTING A PUBLIC ACCURACY TEST FOR THE ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT THAT WILL BE USED TO TABULATE THE VOTES IN PRECINCT 1. THE PUBLIC ACCURACY TEST IS CONDUCTED TO DEMONSTRATE THE COMPUTER PROGRAMMING USED TO TABULATE THE VOTES CAST AT THE ELECTION MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF MICHIGAN LAW.

THE TEST WILL BE CONDUCTED AT 9:00 A.M. ON APRIL 23, 2020.

ALL MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ARE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE.

THE TEST WILL BE CONDUCTED UNDER THE GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-4, THE LIMITATION ON PUBLIC ASSEMBLIES OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-11, AS WELL AS RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING.
