

Special Meeting
Charleston Township Board
April 6, 2000

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by the Supervisor who led those present in the pledge of the allegiance to the flag.

ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS:

Roll was called and members present were: Bell, Whitehead, Samson, Kasson and Kramer. Also present were Bert Gale, Sara Thunman, and Dennis Ward.

It was moved by Kasson, supported by Whitehead to adopt the text, shown as Amendment No. 1 and No. 2, and add it to the Township Zoning Ordinance as presented. Roll Call Vote: Kasson – Y; Whitehead – Y; Bell – Y; Samson – Y; Kramer – Y. CARRIED

Kasson moved to adopt the zoning recommended by the Planning Commission of the property known as Charleston Hills Business and Industrial Park to the Research-Industrial Park district. Samson supported the motion. Roll Call Vote: Kasson – Y; Whitehead – Y; Bell – Y; Samson – Y; Kramer – Y. CARRIED

Dennis Ward asked if the rezoning of the former BFI property included anything north of I-94. He was assured by the supervisor that it did not.

Fran informed the Board that the Kalamazoo County Planning Department had sent him some information concerning training sessions for the Planning Commission and the Zoning Board of Appeals that were going to be held in this area.
